Written commentary, Thesis, and Sermon should be prepared according to the guidelines below. Print one copy and submit it, and create a PDF file and submit the other copy to the Examination Department secretary via email.

Use Letter Size (8.5 x 11) for the document size.

Use Korean font size 11 with 160% line spacing.

Use English font size 12 with double space line spacing.

Thesis should be at least 15 pages, commentary should be at least 10 pages each, and sermon manuscripts should be about 20 minutes long for the sermon.

Thesis and commentary should follow the thesis writing method (Turabian) and use footnotes.

When sending a PDF file, name the file with the applicant's name and thesis title.

Please send all documents as PDF files first by email and by regular mail, then the originals to the Examinations Secretary.

The announcement of successful candidates will be made during the 49th General Assembly, and after the General Assembly, the certificate of passing will be delivered to the presbytery moderator to which the successful candidate belongs, and each applicant can receive the certificate of passing from the Presbytery through the licensure ceremony for the Licenced Preacher.
